

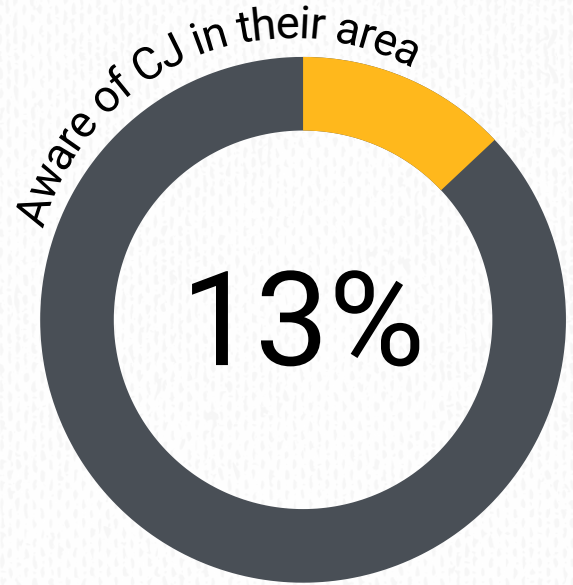
# Communications Insight: Attitudes and Perceptions to Community Justice in 2021



The following research summarises a report commissioned by Community Justice Scotland and completed by an independent Scottish research agency in 2021 on attitudes and perceptions of community justice (CJ) in Scotland.

## COMMUNITY JUSTICE INSIGHT

30% know what CJ is



54% agreed that community justice makes Scotland a safer place to live



Priority focus areas when working with people who have committed crimes (high to low)



Tackling the cause of crime such as substance misuse



Providing stability by addressing issues such as homelessness



Training or employment opportunities



Ensuring that unpaid work is carried out successfully



Support services cited as failing people and therefore contributing to the likelihood of offending
